## WINDOWS XP INSTALLATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Do not connect the evaluation board.
- 2. Run the .msi/.exe file provided, for example, ADI\_Int-N\_Setup\_v7\_4\_3.msi or

ADF435x\_Setup\_v4\_3\_1.exe.

3. The installer downloads and installs Microsoft\* .NET Framework 3.5, if required.

If an Internet connection is not available

- Cancel the installation.
- Run and install WindowsInstaller-KB893803-v2x86.exe (provided on CD).
- Restart the computer, if required.
- Run and install dotnetfx35.exe (provided on CD).
- Repeat Step 2.
- 4. Click Next.




Figure 2. Select Installation Folder




Figure 3. Confirm Installation




Figure 5. Installation Complete




Figure 7. Installing the Software Automatically




Figure 8. Completing the Found New Hardware Wizard

ADF435x\_Setup\_v4\_3\_1.exe.

3. Note that the installer downloads and installs Microsoft .NET Framework 3.5, if required.

If an Internet connection is not available

- Cancel the installation.
- Run and install WindowsInstaller-KB893803-v2-x86.exe (provided on CD).
- Restart the computer, if required.
- Run and install dotnetfx35.exe (provided on CD).
- Repeat Step 2.
- 4. Click Next.




Figure 15. Confirm Installation




Figure 16. Software Installation




Figure 17. Installation Complete
